

Fitting and Wiring Instructions



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR AIR MOVEMENT EQUIPMENT

Air moving equipment may present mechanical, electrical or noise hazards. To minimise risks associated with these potential hazards, it is essential that safety, installation, operation and maintenance instructions are followed. Implementation of these instructions should always be undertaken by technically competent personnel.

Potential mechanical hazards must be eliminated by guarding against access to the rotating parts whilst the air moving equipment is operating. A range of guards are available for this purpose from Vent-Axia.

Installation work, both mechanical and electrical, must be undertaken in accordance with the safety and installation instructions before switching on the unit.

Maintenance work should not be attempted before first switching off and isolating the fan and its control from the electrical supply and ensuring that it cannot be accidentally turned back on again. It is essential to ensure that rotating parts have come completely to rest before maintenance work commences.

Air moving equipment may generate unacceptable noise levels when in operation. Actual sound levels are indicated in the Vent-Axia Industrial catalogue for each product and it may be necessary to take appropriate action to reduce sound levels. A range of products are available for this purpose from Vent-Axia.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>- READ THESE INSTUCTIONS FULLY BEFORE COMMENCING INSTALLATION On receipt of fan, check the following:

- a. That the type and size of the fan is correct for the application.
- b. That the details and the rating plate are appropriate for the application, including: Voltage, Frequency, number of phases (1 or 3) and speed.

Description

This centrifugal fan is designed as a roof extract ventilator. It is supplied fully assembled and ready for installation and incorporates a service switch.

The mounting plate is moulded with a fixed bell-mouth to ensure optimum efficiency and precise alignment. The weather-cowl is also moulded to produce a smooth internal surface and has a tough UV resistant finish. All models are equally suitable for flat or inclined roofs and are suitable for kerb or soaker sheet mounting.

The fan is capable of handling air temperatures up to 40°C continuously.

Mounting

Each fan is supplied and assembled ready for installation.

For easy and quick mounting, the following points are important:

- The fan should be installed with its base plate mounted securely to either a roof kerb or soaker sheet. When fixed to a kerb made of concrete, bricks or wood, make absolutely sure that the surface onto which the fan is mounted is clean and level. In order to ensure an airtight fit, use a seal of non-porous material.
- Lift the cowl off the unit by removing the fixing screws. Remove any packaging material.
- Place the fan on the kerb or soaker sheet. Tighten bolts/screws evenly and not too hard to prevent deformation of the base. Check by hand that the impeller runs smoothly and without fouling.
- 4. If the fan inlet is less than 2.3m high, a suitable guard must be fitted.
- Follow the instructions given in 'electrical connections' to connect the power supply to the fan.
- Re-fit the cowl. It is recommended to cover the screws with a clear silicone sealant.

Electrical Connections

IMPORTANT

- THIS EQUIPMENT MUST BE EARTHED.
- MAINS SUPPLY MUST BE ISOLATED BEFORE MAKING CONNECTION.
 - CONNECTION TO MAINS SUPPLY MUST BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT I.E.E. WIRING REGULATIONS, BS 7671, LOCAL BUILDING AND FACTORY REGULATIONS, OR APPROPRIATE STANDARDS IN YOUR COUNTRY. THE EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE PROVIDED WITH AN ALL-POLE ISOLATOR SWITCH HAVING A CONTACT SEPARATION OF AT LEAST 3mm AND SUITABLY SIZED FUSES OR CIRCUIT BREAKERS. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT WIRING TO THE UNIT BE MADE IN FLEXIBLE CONDUIT TO FACILITATE MAINTENANCE.
- ENSURE SAFETY REGULATIONS AND PRACTICES ARE ADHERED TO WHEN INSTALLING AND USING THIS EQUIPMENT.

Wiring Instructions

WARNING: ISOLATE MAINS SUPPLY BEFORE MAKING CONNECTION.

Ensure switch is in the 'OFF' position.
Remove the lid of the terminal box and connect the unit in accordance with the wiring diagram.
Ensure that the earth connection has been made.
After making wiring connections, check that they are all correct and secure, replace lid ensuring that all screws, nuts and glands are adequately tightened to prevent the ingress of dirt and moisture.

When wiring in conjunction with a speed controller, see instructions supplied with controller.

Notes on Running

Before switching on CHECK:

- · Control unit and motor/fan are secure.
- All relevant guards and covers are fitted.
- Earth connections have been made and are secure.
- Switch on service switch


Routine Inspection / Maintenance

THIS MUST BE UNDERTAKEN BY A COMPETENT PERSON ISOLATE UNIT FROM ELECTRICAL SUPPLY AND ENSURE THAT IT CANNOT BE ACCIDENTALLY TURNED BACK ON


For additional safety during maintenance a SERVICE SWITCH is provided on the terminal box NOTE: This is <u>not</u> an isolating switch and should not be used to start or stop the fan.

- We recommend that after three months the fan should be inspected and cleaned to ensure there is no build up of dirt or other deposits on the impeller or motor. Thereafter, it should be checked and cleaned periodically as experience dictates, or at least twice a year. Please take care not to dislodge any balancing weights fitted on the fan blades. If the fan is handling dust laden air, we recommend that a filter is fitted to the system (suitable filters are available from Vent-Axia Ltd.).
- All Vent-Axia Access fans are fitted with sealed for life bearings and therefore do not require any lubrication.
- 3. Check all fasteners and guards are secure.
